

Student behavior

The students of Medford Township have traditionally been well-behaved, caring, responsible young people. When misbehavior does occur, teachers and administrators try to focus on the behavior being the result of a poor choice. Parents are contacted for additional insight and assistance.

Acts of bullying, fighting, harassment, foul language, and disrespect towards adults and children cannot be tolerated.

Each classroom teacher has established a list of expectations for behavior, which are shared with parents and reviewed with children on a regular basis.

In general, our students are expected to:

1. Use appropriate language in class, on the playground, and on our buses.
2. Maintain a positive attitude.
3. Respect the rights of other students to learn.
4. Avoid any physical or verbal fighting.
5. Maintain satisfactory attendance.
6. Come to class prepared with materials and assignments.
